## **Entry requirements**

---

Applicants are required to meet one or more of the following entry requirements:

1. Completion or prospective completion of the Koutougakkou or Chutokyouikugakkou by March 2016
2. Completion or prospective completion of Year 12 by March 2016
3. Acquisition of the academic achievement which is equivalent or superior to the Koutougakkou level
  - (1) Completion of Year 12 or equivalent curriculum overseas, which is authorized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
  - (2) Completion of the curriculum overseas, which is equivalent to the Koutougakkou curriculum and is authorized by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
  - (3) Completion of the further education at Senshugakkou
  - (4) Authorization by the Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology
  - (5) Success or prospective success in the Koutougakkou-sotugyouteido-ninnteishiken
  - (6) Experience of university education which is authorized by the 2<sup>nd</sup> section of the 90<sup>th</sup> article of Gakkoukyouikuhou and is accepted by the MUIM
  - (7) Acquisition of the academic achievement which is equivalent or superior to the Koutougakkou level and is accepted by the MUIM, and the age of 18 by March 31 2016

Applicants who meet 3-(6) or (7) should contact the MUIM in advance. Applicants who wish their entitlement to sit the entrance examination to be checked should contact MUIM 1 month prior to the start of the application period
