Application Guidelines for Foreign Applicants 2016

School of Acupuncture and Moxibustion

School of Health Sciences and Medical Care

I . QUALIFICATIONS FOR THE EXAMINATION

1. Applicants must be foreigners who have completed a 12-year course of school education in a foreign country, or who are approved by the Ministry of Education as having attained an appropriate level of education.
2. Applicants must be foreigners aged 18 or older who have passed the international baccalaureat.
3. Applicants must be foreigners aged 18 or older who have passed Abitur (Zeugnis der allgemeinen Hochschulreife).
4. Applicants must be foreigners aged 18 or older who have passed the Baccalaureat.
5. Applicants must be individuals who are approved as being fully qualified by the President.

II . ENROLLMENT

Note: Considering the purpose and purport of our university, an applicant who is regarded below the level of specified ability and character should not be permitted to enter this university.

III . APPLICATION PROCEDURE

1. Application period:
Jan. 11 (Monday) through Jan. 22 (Friday), 2016 (except Saturday and Sunday)
2. Application filing:
Bring a complete set of application documents, enclosed in the application document envelope, to the entrance examination information office of this university, or send it by mail to the following address:

3. Submit the following documents:
 - (1) Application for admission: Use the prescribed form.
 - (2) Two photographs:
These must measure 5 cm (H) ×4cm (W), showing the upper half of the body with uncovered head and be taken within a period of three months prior to filing the application. Paste one on the application and the other on the examination admission card.
 - (3) The applicant's most recent diploma from an educational institution must have been issued within a period of three months prior to filing the application.
Note: Attach a Japanese translation of the diploma.
 - (4) Most recent certificate of school achievement from an educational institution must have been issued within a period of three months prior to filing an application.
Note: Attach a Japanese translation of the certificate.
An applicant who has the international baccalaureat prescribed in Application Qualification I -2 must attach a certificate of achievement for the final examinations for six major subjects and a copy of the certificate of qualification.
An applicant who has the Abiturzeugnis prescribed in Application Qualification I -3 must attach the "Zeugnis der allgemeinen Hochschulreife".
An applicant who has the Baccalaureat prescribed in Application Qualification I -4 must attach "Diplôme du Baccalauréat de l' Enseignement du Second Degré".
 - (5) Identification:
This is used to confirm the nationality and residential qualifications of the applicant (e.g., copy of foreign registration, passport, or a certificate from a diplomatic or

consular establishment in Japan).

Note: Identification must be written in either Japanese or English. If it is in another language, attach its Japanese translation.

- (6) The duplicate of Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students Score Report
- (7) Written guarantee:
Use the prescribed form. The guarantor must live in Japan and provide support for the applicant while in university, and take care of both school and living expenses for the applicant while in university.
- (8) Reply envelopes:
Two envelopes for sending the written notice of the results of the examination and the certificate of admission must be self-addressed. One envelope for sending the examination admission card must be self-addressed and stamped.
- (9) Other documents:
Submit as requested by the entrance examination information office of this university.

4. Payment of the entrance examination fee:

Pay the entrance examination fee (¥30,000) when submitting application documents. You should pay in Japanese yen as described below:

- (1) At the reception desk of the entrance examination information office of this university.
- (2) By registered mail.
- (3) By postal money order enclosed with the necessary application documents.

5. The entrance examination permit:

An entrance examination permit will be issued for the applicants who live outside Japan and have completed the prescribed application procedures. This permit is obtainable from the office upon request.

IV. EXAMINATION SUBJECTS

1. Take the Examination for Japanese University Admission for International Students (EJU) in the following two subjects. Concerning the period of application, the date of examination, and the place of examination, see the information from the Association of International Education, Japan (AIEJ).
